

Watering Chart and Garden Care Instructions

Daily, please fill the small watering can and invite a resident to water the garden. This will keep your garden happy and healthy! Please record that watering has been completed by writing the resident's name in the chart below.

- Encourage residents to water the plants in the front and the back of the garden daily. Your garden may need more frequent waterings if your garden is located in a sunny window or dry location. Put your finger into the soil (in several locations, especially the back) to see if it needs water.
- Check large reservoir watering can on the bottom shelf to see if any water has drained. If so, staff should carefully remove and empty this watering can – water can be recycled (but not back into the garden).
- Make sure the fan runs 24 hrs a day.
- Safety locks – After moving garden, make sure **safety locking casters are on**. Breaks are secure when 'ON' is pointing downward.
- Lights are on an automatic timer – please do not manually turn ON/OFF. Notify Eldergrow staff if the light is not automatically turning off at night.
- Please do not place/plant anything in the garden without your Eldergrow Educator's permission. Objects on the garden shelf need a saucer or tray to avoid wood stains.



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
