- **Guess The Number:** Count and fill a glass jar with small wrapped candies or M&Ms. Have each person write down their guess. The person whose guesses closest, wins!
- **Sweet Conversation Starters:**
  - Before starting the game, empty several packets of M&Ms into a large bowl. (This game can also be played with different colored plant leaves!) You want to make sure everyone playing gets at **least five pieces of candy/leaves each**, so be sure you've got enough to play with.
  - On a sheet of paper, write down what each color signifies, for example: Red: Favorite type of music and why / Green: One thing you love / Orange: A person who inspires you, etc. Here are Conversation Starters that you can color code: [Link here](#)
  - You can play the game by passing the bowl around and everyone takes a piece each before revealing their tale; or reveal as they go. (They get to eat their candy piece during the game.)
